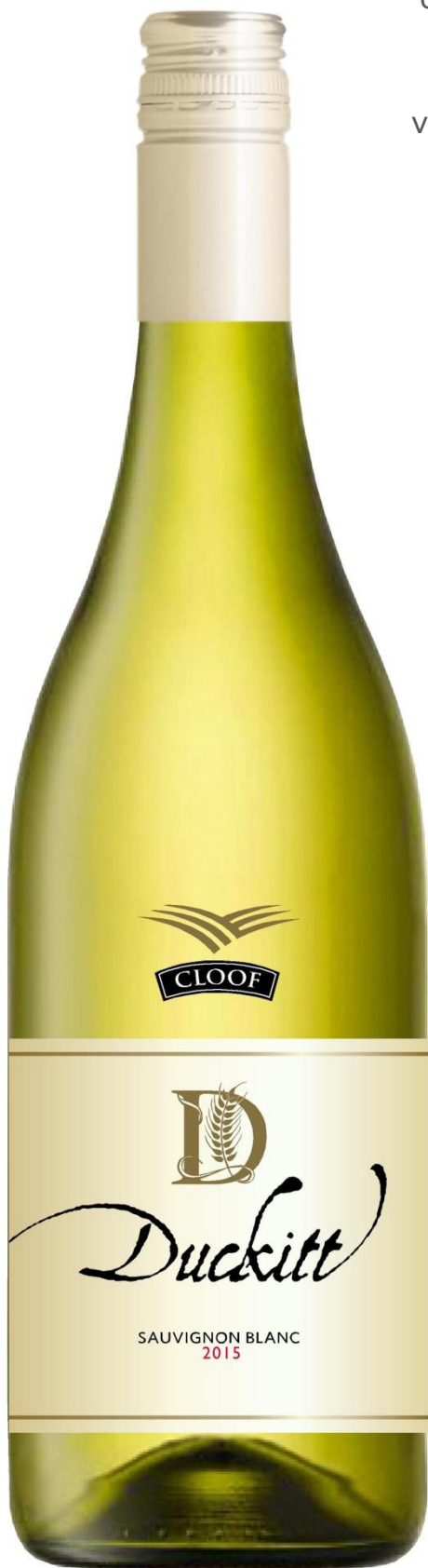


Cloof Duckitt Sauvignon Blanc 2015



This range commemorates William Duckitt, who settled in the Darling region in the early 1800's, after being sent to the Cape of Good Hope to introduce his father's systems and implements of agriculture. Today, another descendant of William Duckitt, Peter Duckitt, is our viticulturist and are responsible for the vineyards at Cloof Wine estate as well as our neighbouring farm, Burgherspost.

Vinification

Four hour skin contact in static de-juicers before pressing. The juice had an 18hr settling period at 12°C before being racked of the lees. Fermentation with French yeast at between 13°C and 15°C lasted for 3 weeks before the wine was dry. After a further 3 months on the fine fermentation lees, the wine was racked and filtered.

Tasting Notes

This wine has a pale white colour with a green tinge and has an explosion of tropical fruit on the palate reminiscent of star-and passion fruit, well supported by a good natural acidity.

Food Pairing

A great accompaniment to fresh seafood, a spring green salad and Japanese cuisine.
